Sprouts are the germinated seed of a vegetable. Different sources of sprouts have various vitamins and minerals, fiber and are full of antioxidants. According to the American Heart Association, "Five-to-seven-day-old seed sprouts can offer more nutrition benefits than mature plants." Fresh sprouts are typically sold in the produce section,

although canned can sometimes be available. It is important to be aware that sprouts have a short shelf life. Check the sell-by date, sniff for any off-putting smell or discard if they are slimy. Keep them in the ventilated container they were sold in for three days. It's important once you bring them home to wash them thoroughly.


